With over 20 years of experience working with kids of all ages, Anne Maxwell, LCSW, RPT-S, is a child and family and play therapist, and an Access Consciousness™ facilitator. She works with children and families and practitioners around the world. Anne is the Executive Director of the Access Possibilities School, a private online school for grades K-12. She presented a workshop at the annual Colorado Association for Play Therapy conference in 2012 called *Family Centered Play Therapy*. From that presentation, she wrote her first book, *The Keys to the Magic - A Play Therapist's Handbook of Family Centered Play Therapy*. Soon after, she coauthored the international best seller, *Would You Teach a Fish to Climb a Tree? A Different Take on Kids with ADD, ADHD, OCD and Autism*.

Anne now travels the world facilitating classes that offer a different perspective on children and families. She teaches tools that anyone who works with kids and families can add to their toolkits. These tools are designed to help kids and families recognize their own abilities and knowing, so that they can create whatever change they would like to have in their lives. If creating faster change in your practice, and less burnout, reduced stress, and more ease for you appeals to you, you might want to check her out.
