## Workshop Description:

### "Hi, I am a Play Therapist and I work with addictions"

*Addictions affect the entire family system and it shows up in the playroom. Come join us as we explore:*

As families seek services to support their child who is struggling with challenging behaviors you are offered a window into the bigger family dynamic. Unique to working in play therapy the child is often the identified client; however it is imperative to engage consistently with the whole family system. This often brings additional challenges including addictions. Come explore common themes that arise in play therapy when addictions are present in family systems. We will break down common myths about addictions and how to help children and families change perceptions, behaviors, and beliefs. Participants will explore their unique gifts as therapists and how to maintain your own self-care.

## Workshop Objectives:

1. Participants will be able to describe common themes that arise in play therapy when addictions are present within the family including: hyper-vigilance, numbing, unpredictability, shame, guilt, and incongruence.
2. Participants will be able to conceptualize the identified client's presenting behaviors and goals for play therapy interventions as a potential catalyst for shifting the families addiction cycle.
3. Participants will learn and apply tips for talking with families participating in play therapy about: patterns and beliefs about addiction, ability to change, sobriety, and recovery.
4. Participants will identify the brilliant gifts they bring to play therapy when working with those affected by addictions and how to maintain self-care.
